**DSF APPLICATION AND FAFSA WORKSHOPS

**What you should bring to complete your FAFSA:**

***For the FAFSA Application:***

- FAFSA PIN #s (*parent AND student*). You may apply for a Personal Identification Number at the workshop.
- Social Security Numbers (*parent AND student*)
- Birthdates: month/day/YEAR (*parent and student*)
- Driver's license or Colorado ID card (*parent AND student*)
- 2008 W-2 Forms and other records of money earned last year (*parent AND student, if applicable*)
- Student's 2008 Federal Income Tax Return (*If applicable*)
- Parents' 2008 Federal Income Tax Return (*if you have not filed taxes yet, bring 2007 tax forms*)
- 2008 untaxed income records (*if applicable*)
  - Social Security benefits statement
  - Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)
  - Veterans benefits records
- Savings account information
- Business and **investment mortgage** (*not the home in which you and your family live*) information, business and farm records, stock, bond, and other investment records
- Your alien registration or permanent resident card (*if you are not a US Citizen*)

**What you should bring to complete your TAXES:**

**For your 2008 Taxes:** (Please see a complete list of necessary paperwork and dates, times, locations for tax preparation sites, Denver Asset Building Coalition: [www.DenverABC.org](http://www.DenverABC.org) )

**\*\* PLEASE NOTE:** Denver Scholarship Foundation cannot provide tax help or advice. \*\*

- Your Social Security card, Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN) – or an accurate record;
- Photo Identification such as a driver's license;
- Your spouse, if filing a joint tax return;
- Federal tax return package (if you received one in your mailbox);
- All Forms W-2, Wage and Tax Statement, from all your employers for the year 2008.
- Any and all Forms 1099 you (and your spouse if filing jointly) received.
- A copy of your last year's federal and state tax returns, if you kept copies;
- A copy of any year-end bank account statements showing any interest earned;
- A copy of any educational expenses paid to a qualified educational institution
- Lists, statements, bills, or receipts of your expenses for out of pocket medical and dental, property taxes, auto vehicle registration, home mortgage interest, casualty losses, charitable contributions, and other miscellaneous expenses (in order to "itemize your deductions," to reduce your taxes);
- If you itemized deductions in the previous year-Schedule A, the state tax refund you received: Form 1099-G;
- Tax ID numbers of the provider(s) (Social Security or Federal ID numbers) for any child care provided (Child and Dependent Care Credit);
- A bank account and routing number if selecting a direct deposit (refund) or direct debit (balance due). Most DABC Super Sites can open a bank account for free if you do not already have one. *If electronically filing, direct deposit refunds take 10-14 business days, versus 45 days for a paper check;*
